Incident Summary – February 2021



Background

The following incidents were reported in February 2021. Medium and High Reasonable Potential for Harm (RPH) incidents are covered in more detail in separate alerts.

Practical Guidance

02-05-21, Colville Lake Winter Road, NTPC Incident, Low RPH

- Event: While driving from Norman Wells to Colville Lake worker lost cell phone.
- Response: Phone's Subscriber Identity Module card disconnected.

02-06-21, Norman Wells, NTPC Incident, Low RPH

- Event: Worker slipped on bucket step, finger caught and twisted in grab handle.
- Response: Worker sought medical attention, modified duties not required. Identify slip hazards as part of Tailboard and discuss with crew.

02-15-21, Inuvik, NTPC Incident, Low RPH

- Event: Worker verbally harassed by intoxicated member of the public during bank run.
- Response: Bank runs scheduled during business hours.

02-16-21, Yellowknife, NTPC Incident, Medium RPH

- Event: G14 engine oil was overfilled.
- Response: Operations to investigate.
