Practical Guidance

9-07-16, Sachs Harbour, NTPC Incident, Low RPH:

- Event: Spill less than one liter.
- Response: Reported to spill line.

11-25-16, Fort Smith, NTPC Incident, Low RPH:

- Event: Ankle strain
- Response: Medical treatment

11-28-16, Fort Simpson, NTPC Incident, High RPH:

- Event: Fall from Ladder resulted in leg injury
- Response: To be investigated

11-28-16, Yellowknife, Contractor Incident, Med RPH:

- Event: Taxi dangerous driving
- Response: Reported to the taxi company

11-29-16, Yellowknife, NTPC Incident, Low RPH:

- Event: Backed up truck into other vehicle
- Response: Backup camera to be installed

11-30-16, Yellowknife, Contractor Incident, Low RPH:

- Event: Hotel fire alarm

<p>12-20-16, Inuvik, NTPC Incident, Low RPH:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Event: Slip and fall on icy ground - Response: Gravel spread in parking area
<p>12-23-16, Fort Simpson, Public Incident, High RPH:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Event: Tractor trailer snagged NWtel line and pulled line and mast off - Response: Service connection repaired. Incident report requested from company involved
<p>12-30-16, Yellowknife, NTPC Incident, High RPH:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Event: Truck floor mat caused accelerator pedal to stick open - Response: Truck mat removed and other trucks checked
